## WHO WE ARE

516NOW is a Christian, not-for-profit organization. We seek to build holy, prosperous, and sustainable communities throughout the world by working together with people in target communities to create sustainable projects that glorify God. We do this by:

- Operating ongoing programs and projects
- Providing logistical support for any group wishing to engage in poverty alleviation
- Partnering with other individuals and organizations that can provide value to target communities

## **2019: WHAT WE ACCOMPLISHED**

Although political violence in Nicaragua subsided in 2019, tensions remained; 516NOW elected to suspend all mission trips there. However, our Nicaraguan team continued to operate programs and projects. We also continued to develop connections, projects, and programs in our new target communities in El Salvador and the Dominican Republic. The following is a partial list of what God accomplished through 516NOW in 2019.

## **Operation of 516NOW Programs**

- New 516NOW website (516now.org)
- New bread making business in Barrio Roberto Clemente, (Diriamba, Nicaragua)
- 516NOW radio station raised funds for children with cancer
- In partnership with Lead Like Jesus (leadlikejesus.com), our first seminar was taught in the Dominican Republic
- Women's Empowerment in the Dominican Republic: Bible study and jewelry-making

## Construction

- Continued construction of Palacagüina Christian Academy (now K-3)
- Our first two mission teams travelled to the Dominican Republic; one rebuilt a church in a very poor community
- New roof at the main building at APAN (a Nicaraguan non-profit also working in Barrio Roberto Clemente)

## **Prosperity Through Partnerships**

- Two 516 missionaries travelled to El Salvador to advise on new programs there
- Three youth camps in the Dominican Republic in partnership with Sowing for Eternity Ministries (sowingforeternity.wordpress.com)
- Established a partnership with APAN (see "construction" above)
- Partnership with Lead Like Jesus (leadlikejesus.com) to provide seminars in our target communities
- Beginning partnership with Men for Missions (onemissionsociety.org)

## Prayer Needs

- Additional SSK sponsors for school children
- An end to the political and economic financial depression in Nicaragua
- · Financial support for our radio station (severely impacted by financial situation in Nicaragua)
