BUILDING NEW ROADS

Another example of the impact a mission's trip can make; our team funded a community project to repair a local neighborhood road. In addition to PCA donating more than 30 loads of material from our hill, the project included the installation of culverts to divert runoff and protect the road for years to come. This project was a partnership with the families who live in this area. In addition to living out our faith through service projects, we will host an evangelism outreach to dedicate the new road.



2022 PROJECTS AND GOALS

2022 PCA Projects, by importance, include:

- ➤ 6th grade desks \$2,150 FULLY FUNDED
- Finish back wall \$1,330 (\$500 Raised) \$830 Needed
- Finish front fence \$750
- Multi-Purpose Center (MPC) (Cancha) Possibly up to \$90K
 - Phase I: Front Foundation \$4,000
 - o Phase II: Concrete Floor \$TBD
- ➤ 2nd Level Sewing Space/Mission Housing \$10,000
- Expand roofing over 4th-6th grade play area \$6,300

We want to give God the glory in one more update on having the following projects **fully funded:** PCA Water Tank/System (\$1,650), 6th Grade Classroom (\$6,300), Paint School (\$2,000)


June Missions trip was a success, and God met every need.
